Transportation

If you're studying or living outside East Java, you're responsible for arranging your own travel to Malang. Here are the most convenient options:

✈ **By Air:** You can fly directly to **Juanda International Airport (SBY)**. It's a international airport located about 1,5 hours from the Malang City .



Transportation will be provided only from Juanda Airport to the Trix House in Malang.

The following is the schedule of the pick-up transportation:

✈ **By Air:** You can fly directly to **Malang Abdul Rachman Saleh Airport (MLG)**. It's a small but efficient airport located about 30 minutes from the city center.

🚆 **By Train:** Enjoy scenic views and a comfortable ride by taking a train to **Malang Station (ML)**, located in the heart of the city.



🚌 **By Bus:** Several bus companies operate routes to Malang from major cities. You'll arrive at **Terminal Arjosari**, the main bus terminal in Malang.

Once you arrive at the airport, train station, or bus terminal, you can easily book an **online taxi** using apps like **Gojek, Grab, or Maxim** to reach your designated guest house (please refer to the name list provided).



We recommend downloading these apps in advance and ensuring your mobile data is active upon arrival. Safe travels, and we look forward to welcoming you in Malang!

Do and Don't

✓ DO	✗ DON'T
Follow university regulations and Indonesian laws. 1. Always carry your passport, KITAS, or student ID card. 2. Respect the schedule, workshop rules, and academic regulations.	Do not violate Indonesian laws or visa regulations. 1. Do not work, trade, or conduct activities beyond the workshop permit. 2. Do not misuse your student or visit visa.

✓DO	✗DON'T
Respect local culture and customs. 1. Use polite language and gestures. 2. Dress modestly and appropriately on campus. 3. Men are expected to wear shirts or collared tops (not T-shirts), and women should dress neatly, avoiding transparent or revealing clothing.	Do not possess, use, or trade illegal substances. 1. Do not bring or consume narcotics, cannabis (marijuana), alcoholic beverages, or medicines that may be legal in your home country but are illegal in Indonesia. 2. Examples include cannabis (marijuana), kratom, khat, and some prescription drugs containing psychotropic or opioid substances. 3. Indonesian law imposes very strict penalties for such offenses, including imprisonment.
Use polite Bahasa Indonesia whenever possible. 1. Use polite expressions such as Excuse me, Thank you, Sorry. 2. Try to interact with locals using simple Indonesian phrases.	Avoid alcohol consumption in restricted areas. 1. Consumption of alcohol is prohibited in the campus area, academic activity zones, and participant accommodations during the workshop period. 2. Violations of this rule may lead to formal warnings or disciplinary action from the organizer or the university.
Maintain academic integrity and teamwork. 1. Respect other participants' opinions in discussions.	Avoid behavior that violates social or moral norms. 1. Do not engage in vigilantism, fights, or violent behavior.

✓ DO	✗ DON'T
2. Be punctual and complete group responsibilities.	2. Do not engage in prostitution or immoral activities.
Build positive relationships with the local community. 1. Greet people with a smile and polite greeting. 2. Respect prayer times and local social norms.	Avoid disrespect toward local culture or religion. 1. Avoid wearing revealing clothes in public. 2. Avoid eating, smoking, or acting disrespectfully at places of worship.
	Do not commit academic misconduct. 1. Do not cheat, plagiarize, or copy another participant's work. 2. Avoid using your phone during sessions without permission.

Additional Information

- **Weather:** Malang will be warm and humid at the end of October, with temperatures around 27°C to 34°C (81°F to 93°F). Most days are sunny, with occasional light rain. Please bring an umbrella or a raincoat if necessary.
- **Clothing:** Wear light, breathable clothes and bring sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat to stay comfortable outdoors. Especially for Bromo Tour, please bring a thick jacket, scarf, hat, gloves, and shoes.
- **Essentials:** Pack personal items such as toiletries, medications, and anything else you need daily.
- **Footwear:** Use comfortable walking shoes for campus tours and activities.

- **Cash:** Keep some cash for personal expenses like dinner, payment for Bromo Tour or shopping.
